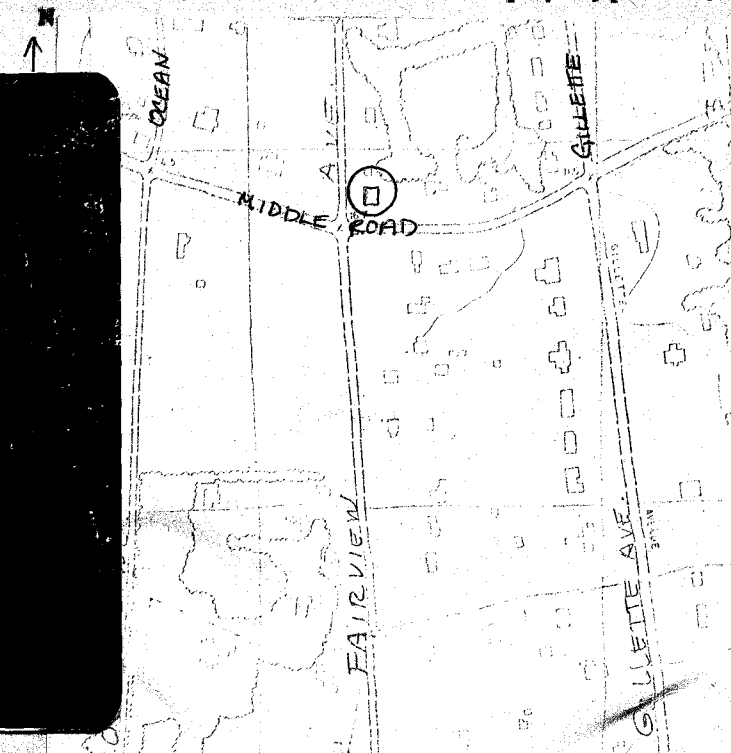

This was the Clarke Smith farmhouse, built c. 1810, according to Charles Dickerson, in A History of the Sayville Community, Owner reports a brick cellar under front room.
