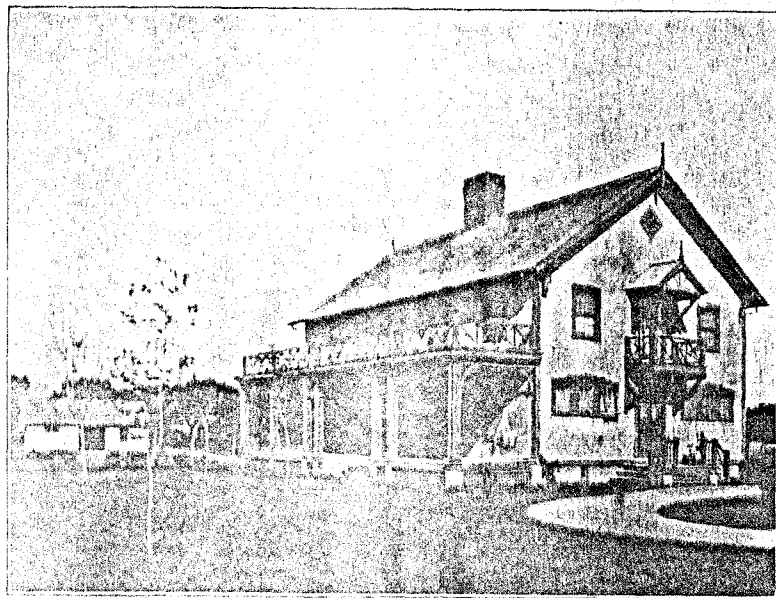
20. HISTORICAL AND ARCHITECTURAL IMPORTANCE:

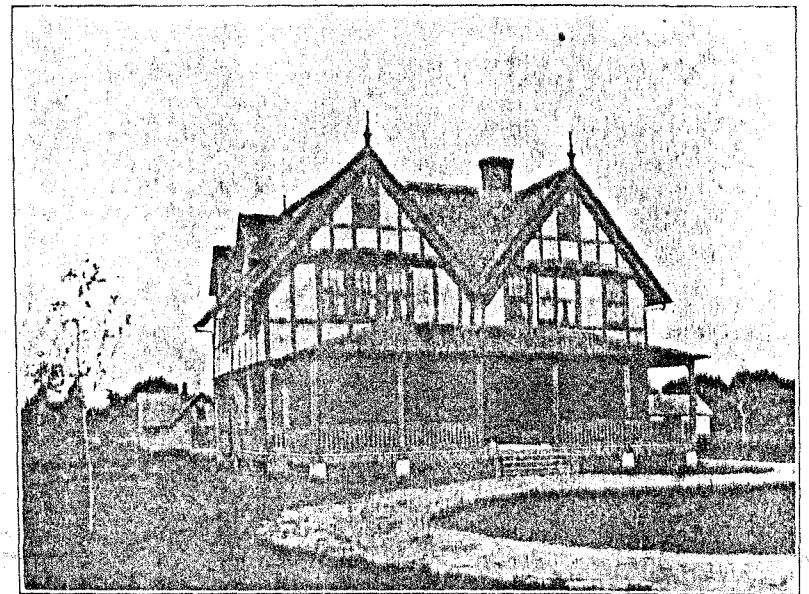

Two acres with two hundred four frontage. Price for the season, \$700.

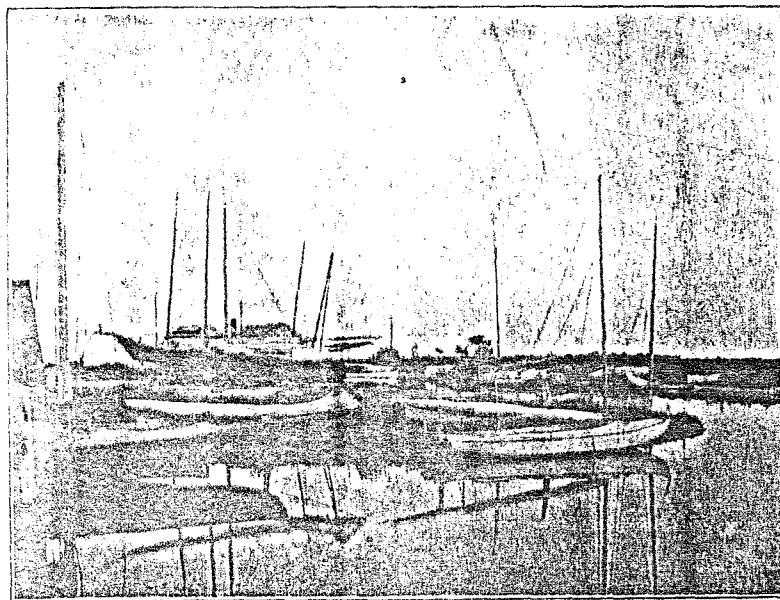


COTTAGE "C."
