1440 Locust Avenue is a $2 \frac{1}{2}$ story, three bay, side entrance plan, gable roof house set perpendicular to the street. The house features an original semi-wrap around porch with sawn spandrels and turned posts. Scallop shingles are visible in the gable peak under the modern comp-
