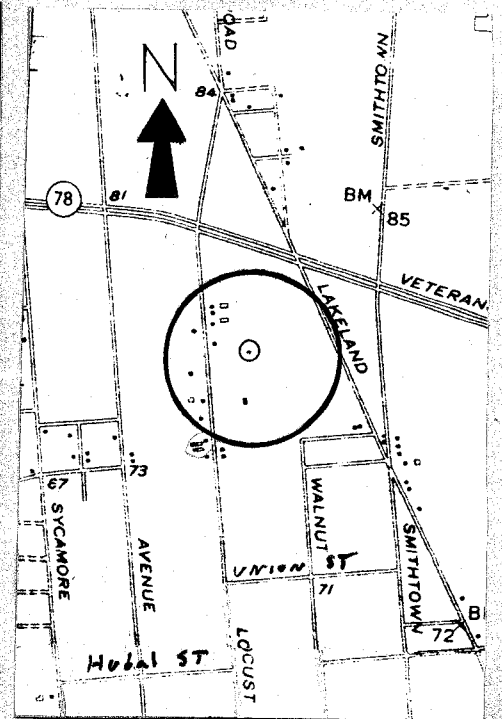

The Kouril House has been recently moved to a Bohemia Historical Society property on the east side of Locust Avenue, south of the Veterans Memorial Highway in the residential neighborhood of Bohemia. The house is set back from the road on a primarily open parcel, marked with a sign.

18. OTHER NOTABLE FEATURES OF BUILDING AND SITE (including interior features if known):

The Kouril House is a 1½ story, side entrance plan, gable roof house with a single bay, 1½ story wing on the north and an attached, 1½ story garage wing on the south with a low cupola. The principle (west) facade of the main block features a semi-hexagonal bay window.
