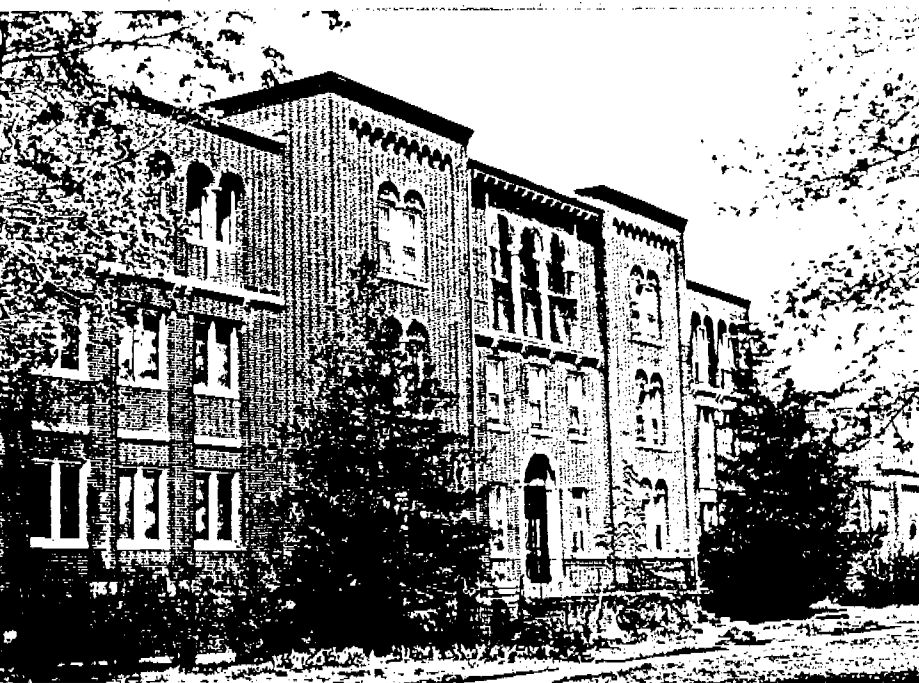

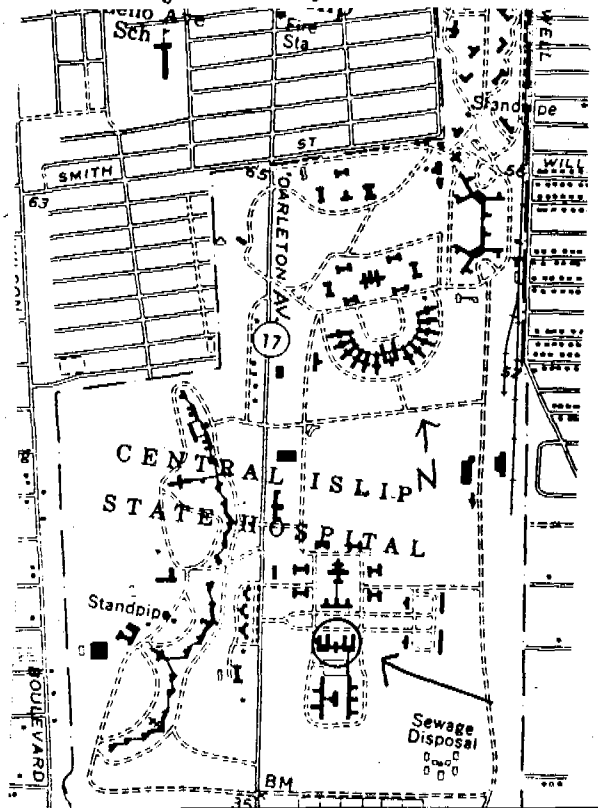

20. HISTORICAL AND ARCHITECTURAL IMPORTANCE:

Building 7 is in the Tuscan style and consists of a small center unit flanked by 2 very large matching wings on east and on west. The center unit is a small 2-story, brick unit with hip roof of slate, articulated brick cornice, and a small arcade of 3 round topped windows on south facade of 2nd floor is visible above the projecting 1 story, 3-bay south entrance. [On the similar north facade, the small arcade is located in a projecting gable roof bay.] Parapet roof entrance facade with arcaded brick recessed panel. Round topped entrance ~~facade~~ ~~with arcaded brick~~ doorway is decorated with voussoirs and pilasters. The matching flanking wings each have their own entrances, also on north facade. They are 3-story and basement, hip-roof units of multi-bays with slightly projecting hip roof end-panels with paired arcaded
