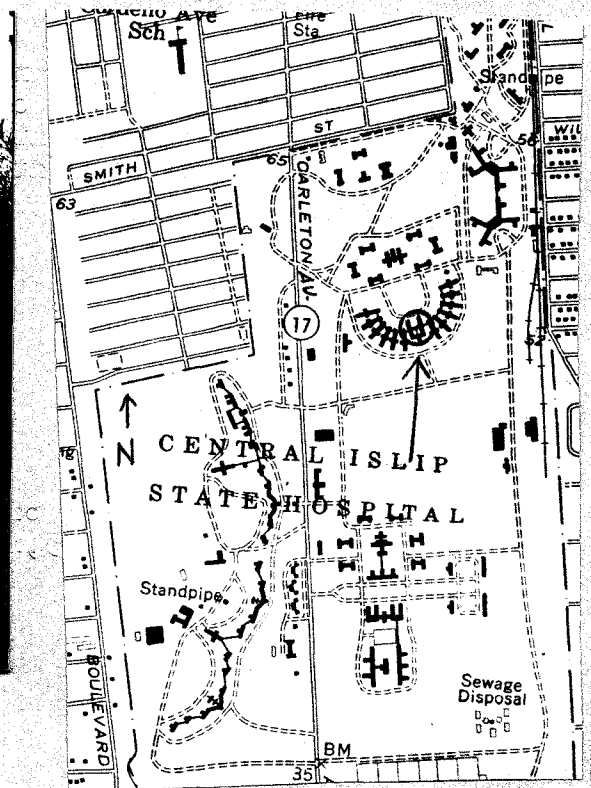

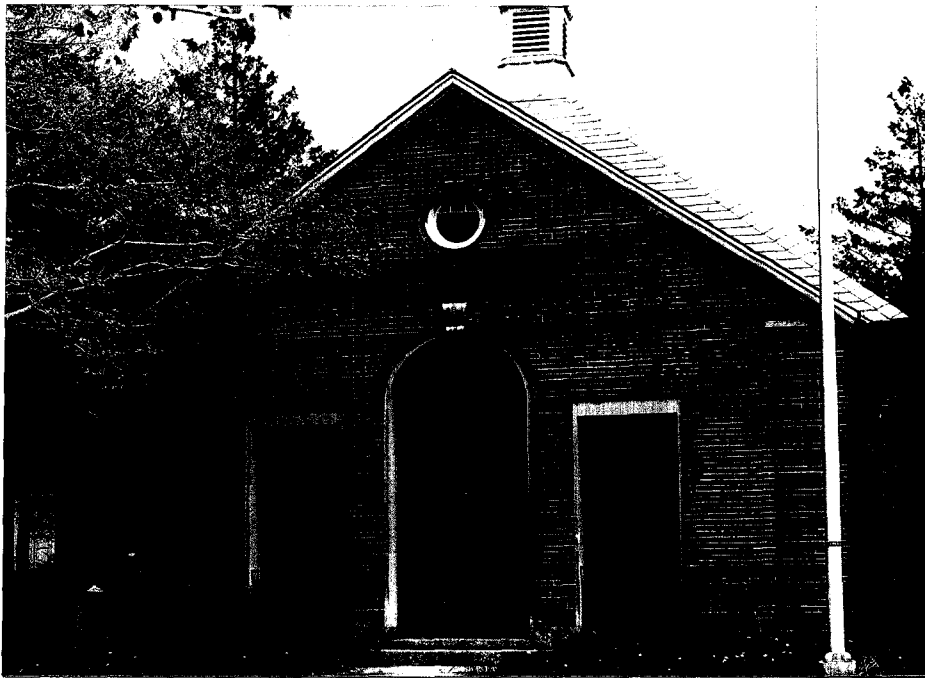
20. HISTORICAL AND ARCHITECTURAL IMPORTANCE:

The building is a large, U-shaped, dining & kitchen structure. Matching gabled entrances on the north, projecting from 3 bay, pyramidal roofed units which terminate the two arms of the "U". A finely articulated cupola punctuates the center of the main roof.
