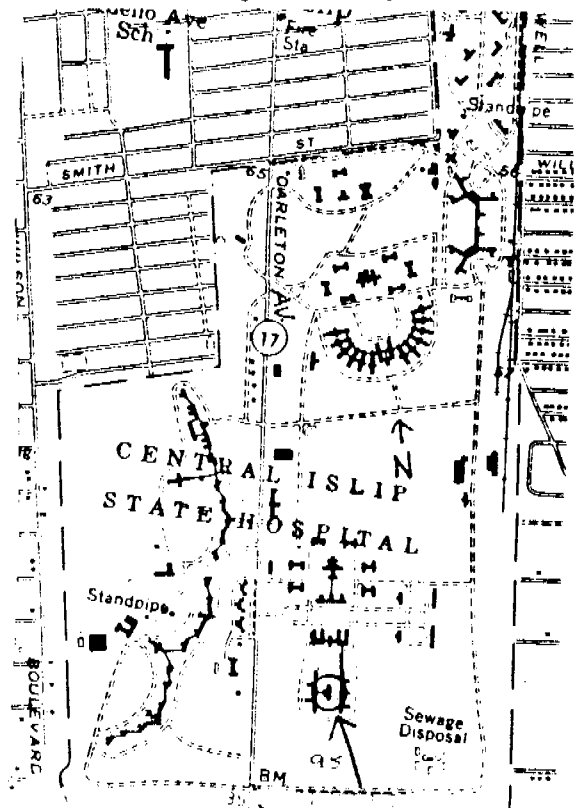

## 20. HISTORICAL AND ARCHITECTURAL IMPORTANCE:

The building is a 4 story and basement, hip roof main section facing the west with articulated brick cornice- ~~with~~<sup>no</sup> flat roofed wings on east(kitchen) on north and on south. Two wings projecting to the west are characterized by inserted square hip-roof units with matching articulated brick cornices and round windows(oculi) in frieze stories. The projecting 1-story brick entrance with parapet roof has round - headed recessed doorway with decorative voussoirs and pilasters.
