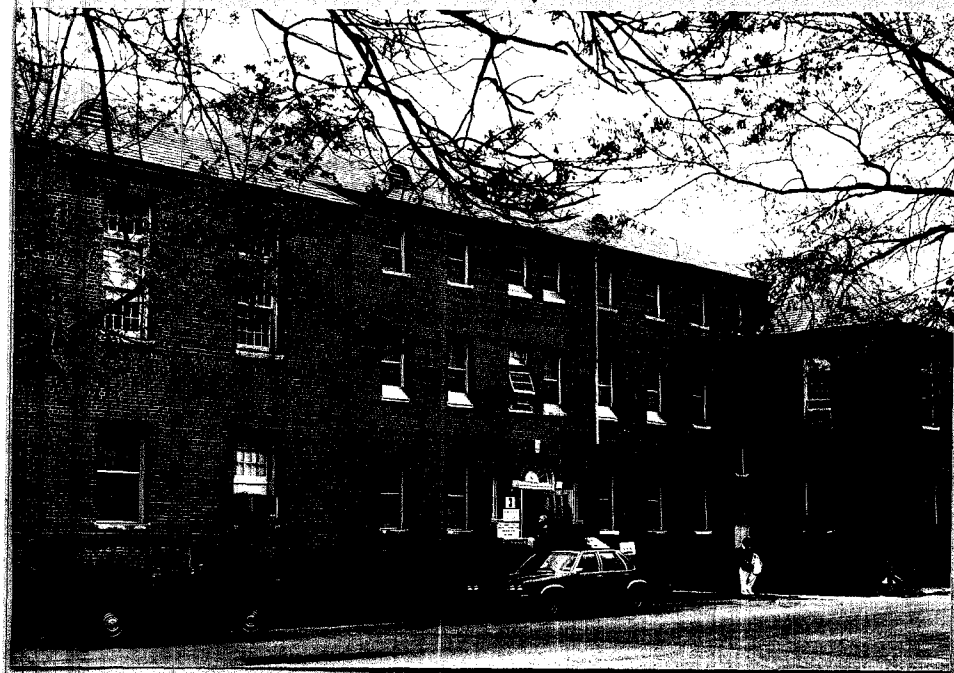

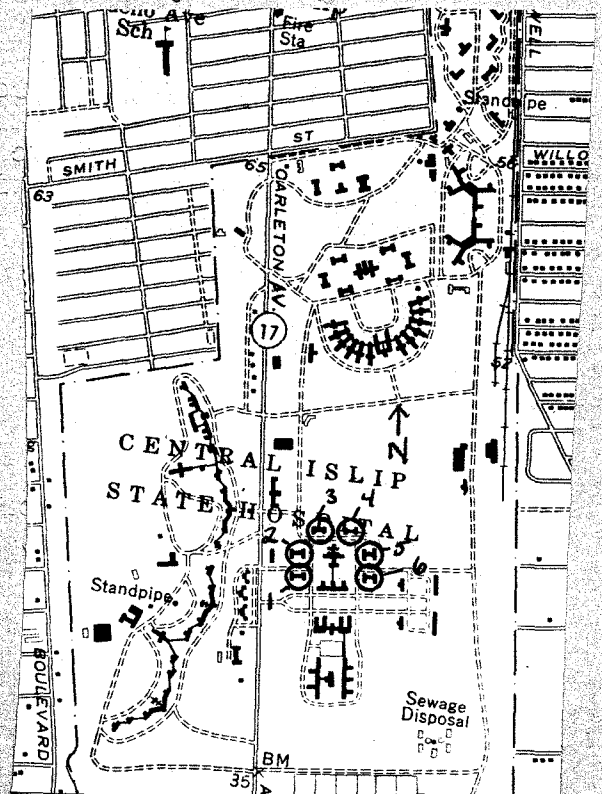

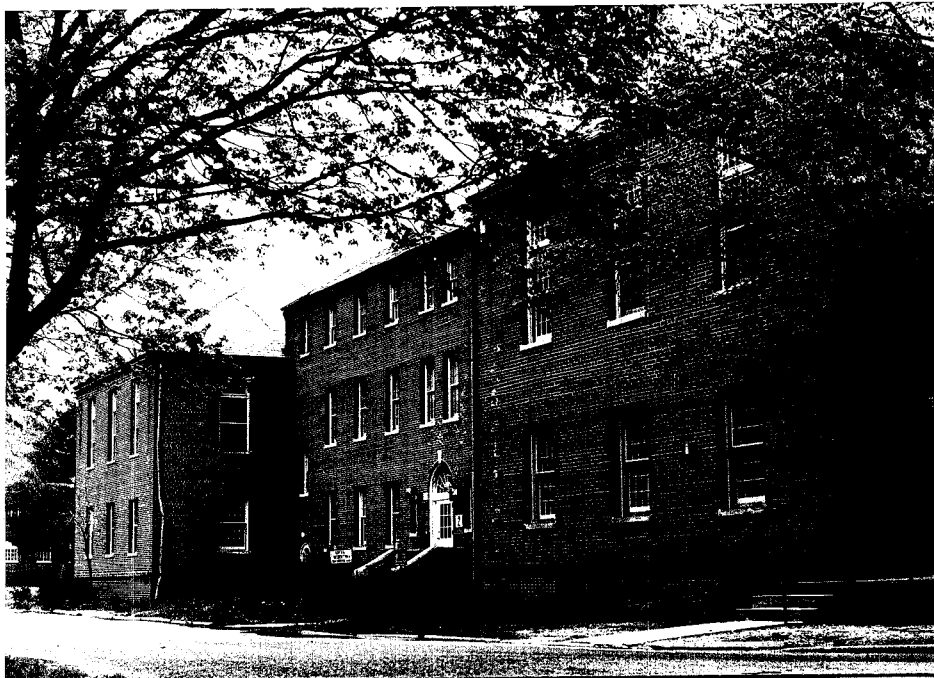
20. HISTORICAL AND ARCHITECTURAL IMPORTANCE:

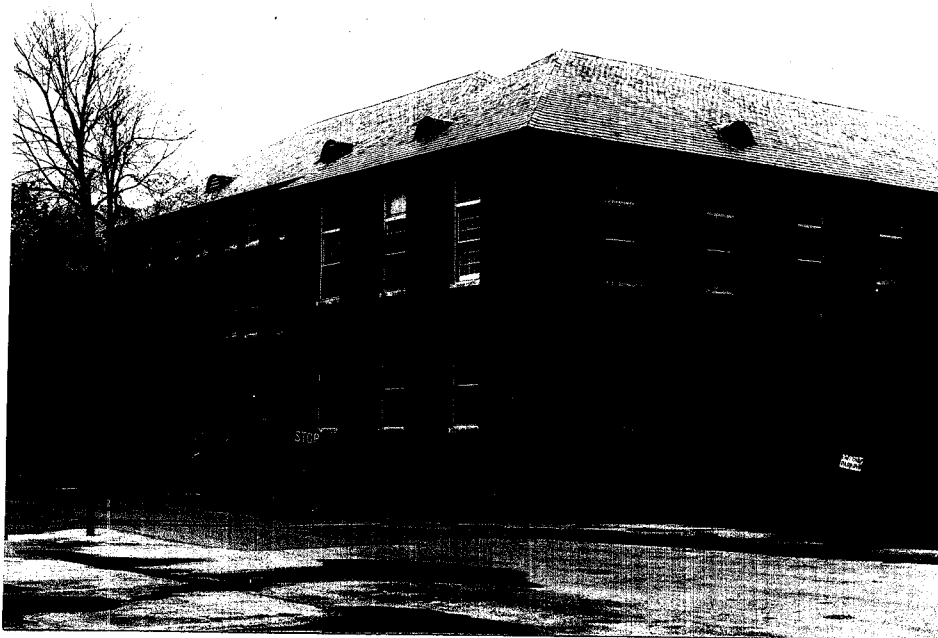

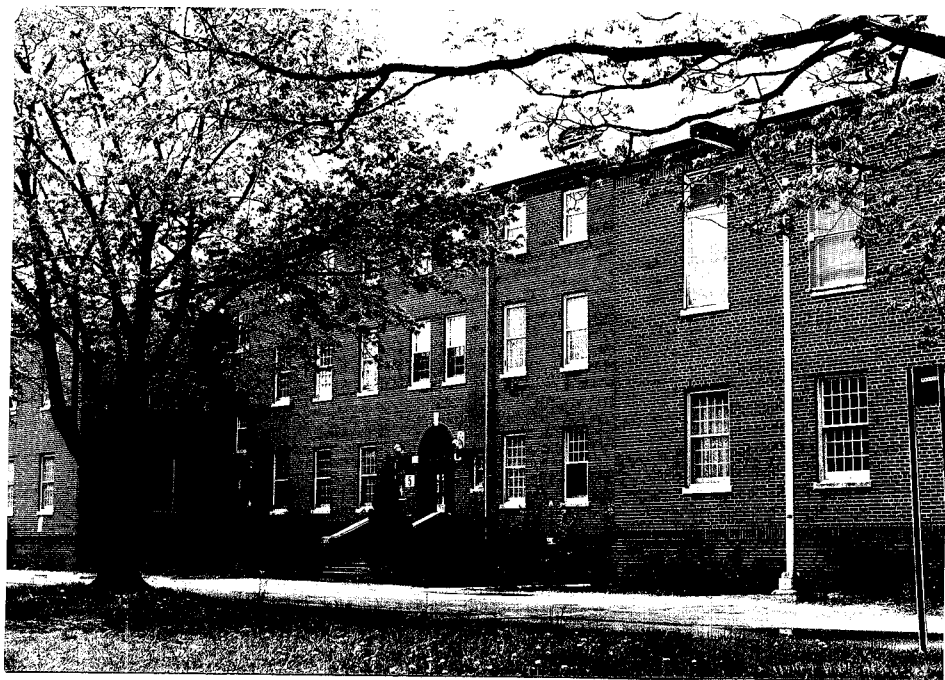

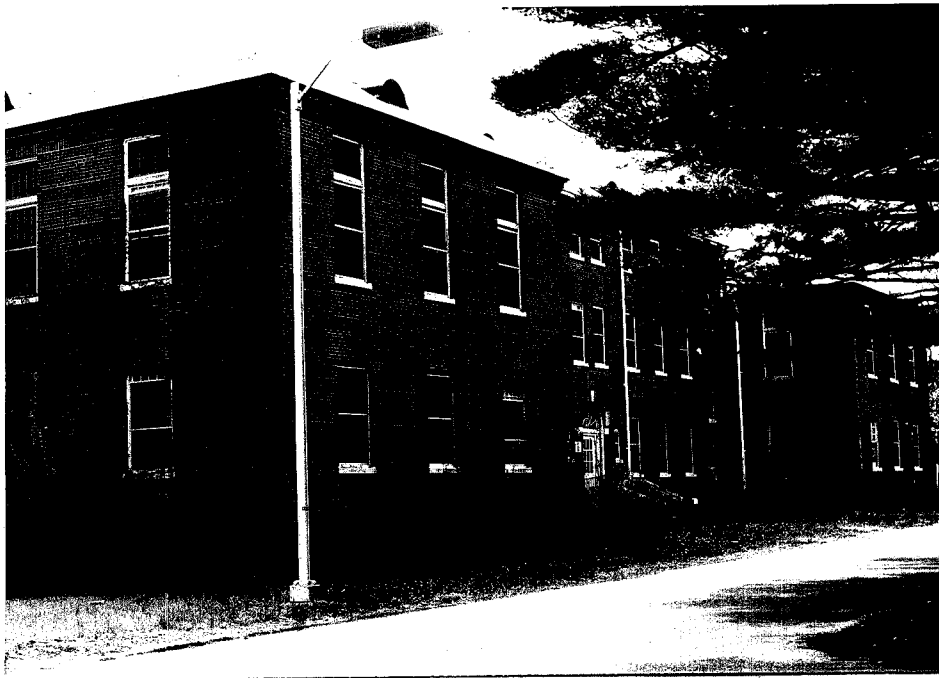
