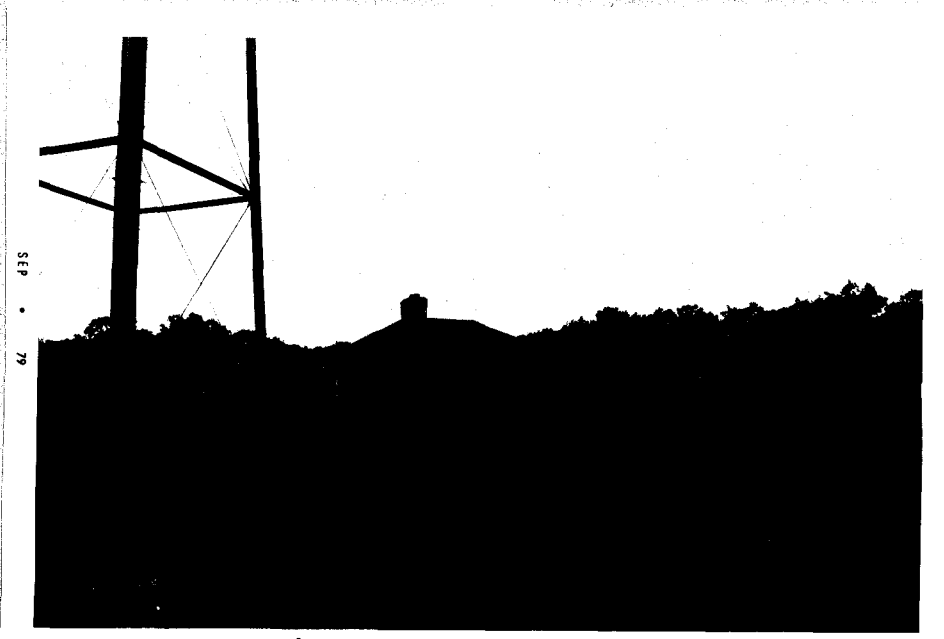

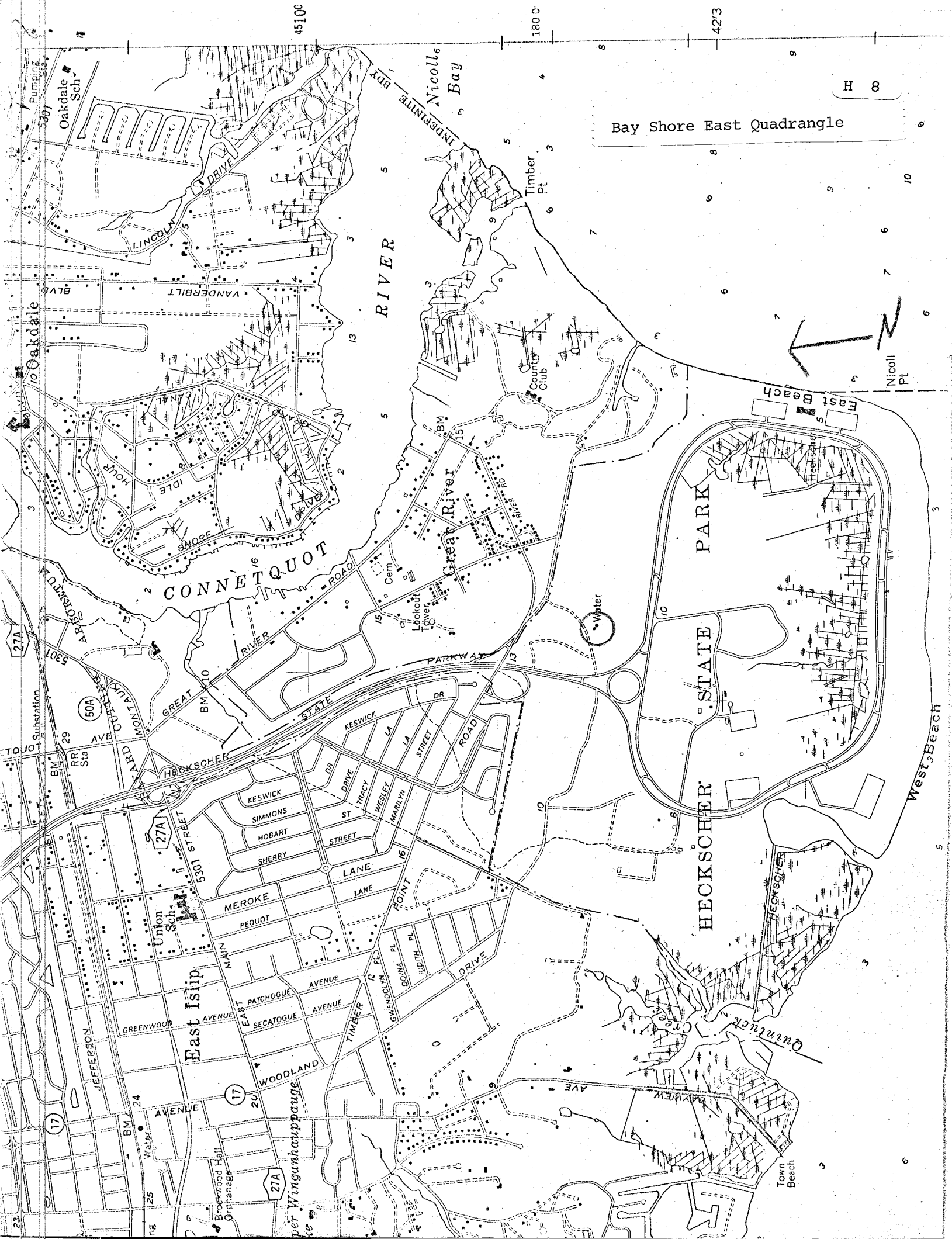

Very elegant pump house, typical of the governmental architectural style of the 1930's. It is also typical of the architects style of that time.

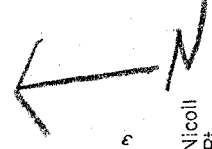
