1. NAME OF DISTRICT: Union Boulevard District - Islip

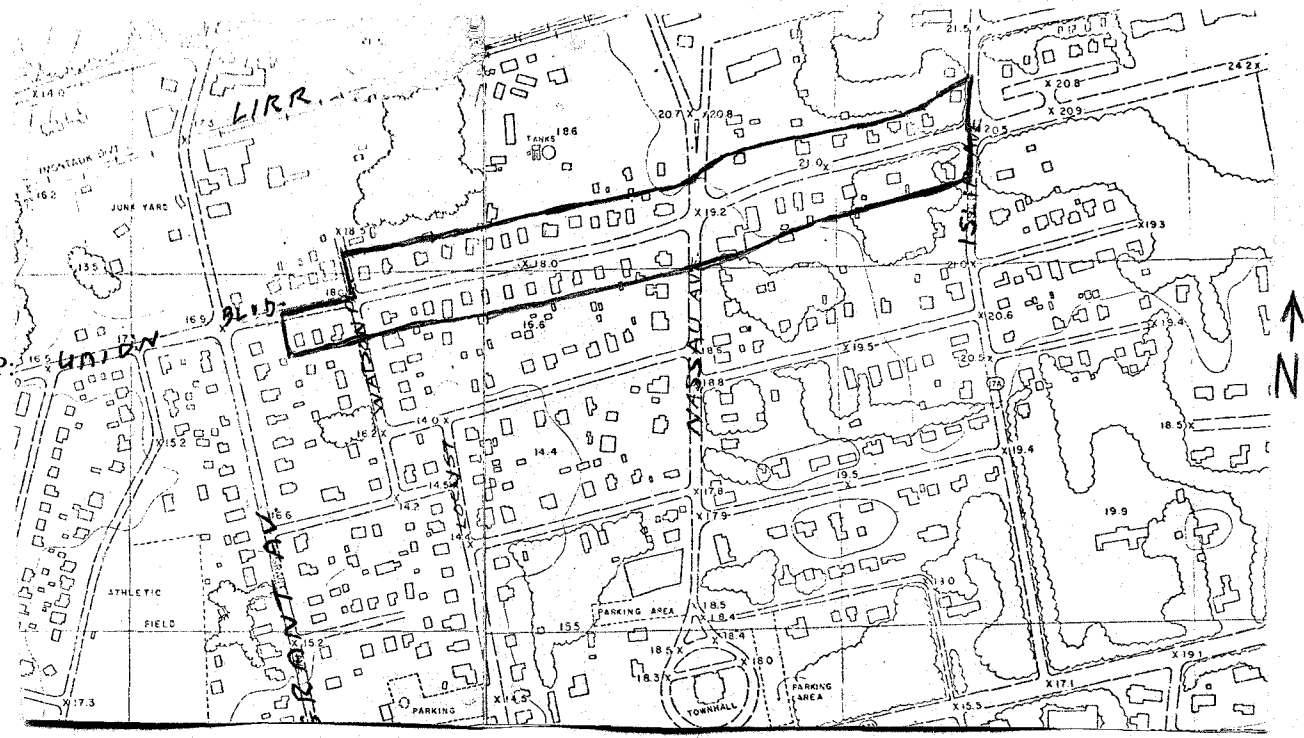

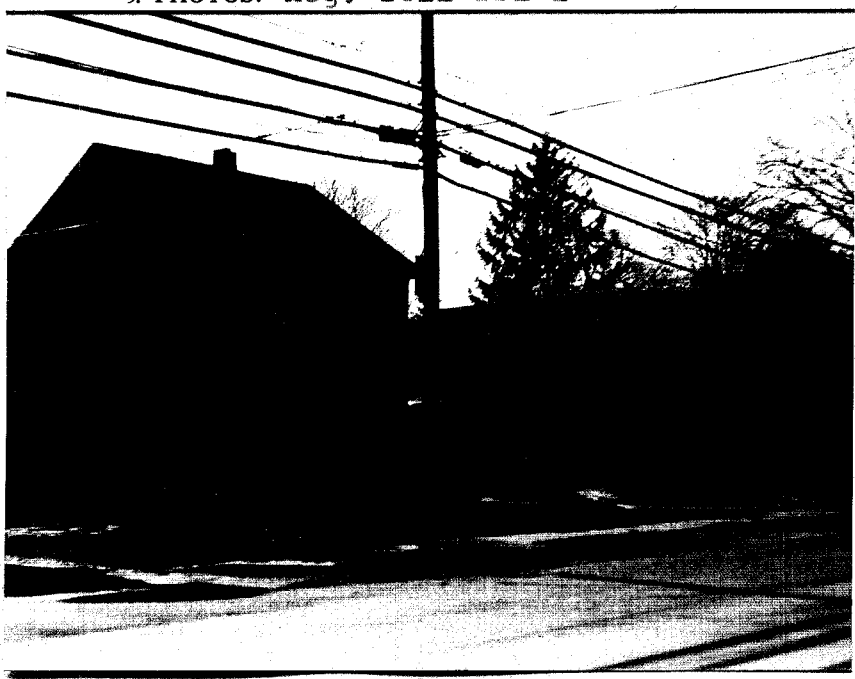
