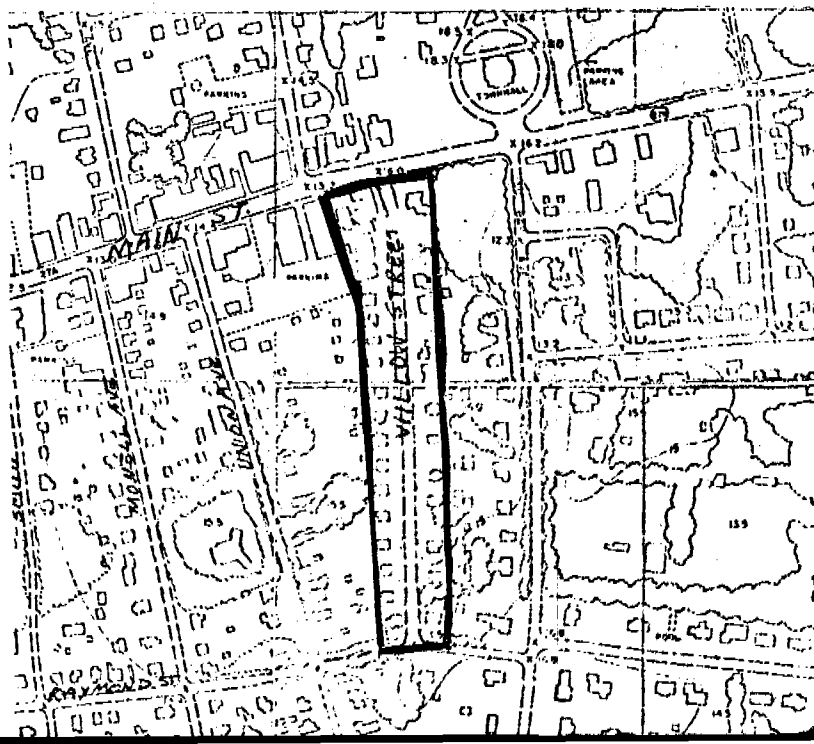
3. DESCRIPTION:
