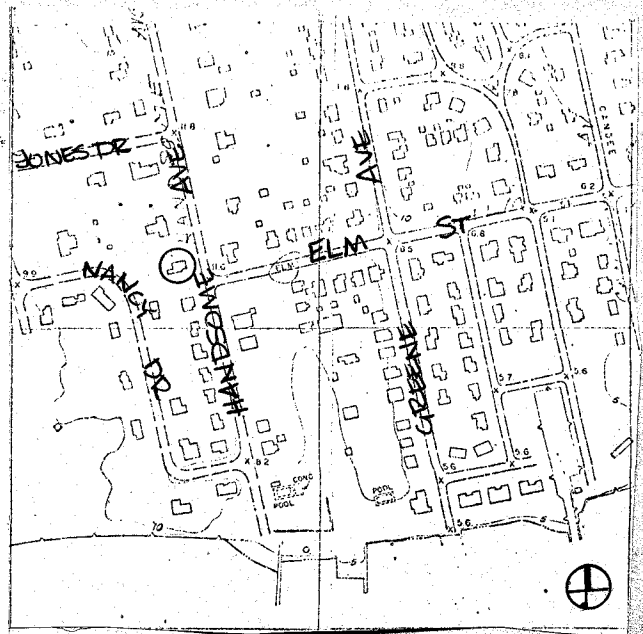

18. OTHER NOTABLE FEATURES OF BUILDING AND SITE (including interior features if known):

Very wide recessed brick entrance with brick piers; gatehouse facade is continuation of this brick wall. Entrance has large iron fencing and gates. Gatehouse is 22 story hip roof house, with brick 1st story and shingled 2nd story. Projecting grouped windows at 2nd floor, supported on brackets. Pilastered corbelled brick chimney.
