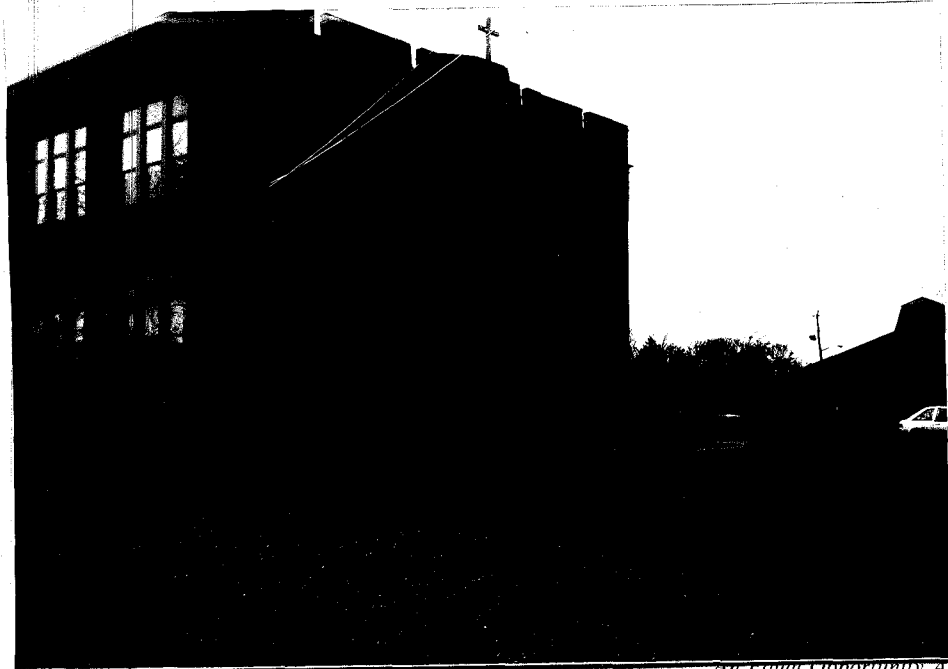

20. HISTORICAL AND ARCHITECTURAL IMPORTANCE: *None to our knowledge. After the Diocese of Brooklyn established St. Lawrence the Martyr Parish in Sayville, 1895, the parish proceeded in 1924 to initiate construction of St. Lawrence School which was intended to be a parish facility consisting of 8 classrooms.*

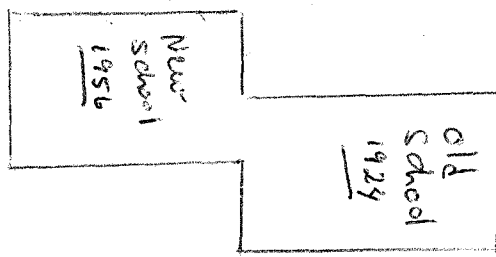
