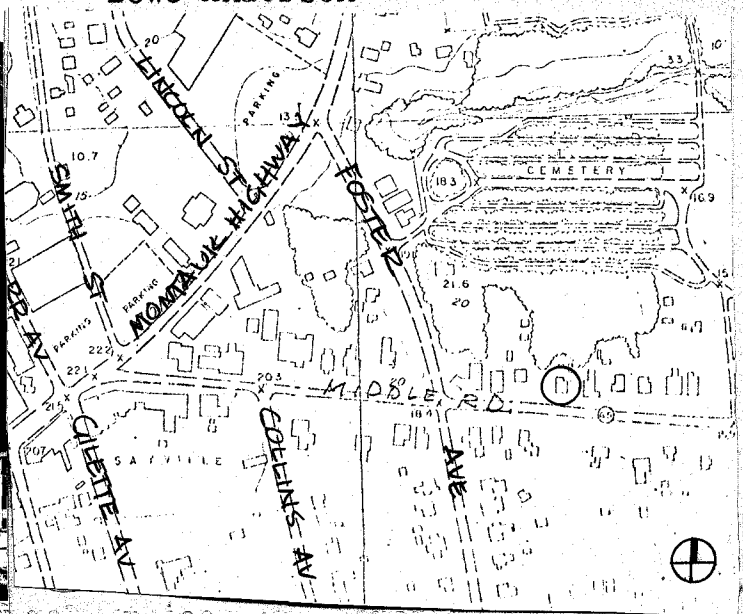

18. OTHER NOTABLE FEATURES OF BUILDING AND SITE (including interior features if known):

1½ story, pilastered gable roofed, late Greek Revival House with 3 bay 1st floor and 1 bay 2nd floor with 1 story 3 bay wing to the east. Centered entrance crosseted surround, high roof plate with freize windows on west facade, porch with turned posts and sawn spandrels, picket fence with top rail surrounds property.

20. HISTORICAL AND ARCHITECTURAL IMPORTANCE:

The Yarrington residence is the former home of one of the Pioneer settlers of Sayville. It survives today, still resplendent in its early 19th century spirit, and is a Designated Town Landmark. Mrs. Ruth Dougherty of the Sayville Historical Society reports that this is known as the Nettie Crosby house.
