Anderson, L.

*Forge*

-*Sequel to Chains*; Separated from his friend Isabel after a daring escape from slavery, fifteen-year-old Curzon serves as a free man in the Continental Army at Valley Forge until he and Isabel are thrown together, as slaves once more.

Barnhouse, R.

*The Book of the Maidservant*

-In 1413, a young maidservant accompanies her deeply religious mistress, Dame Margery Kempe, on a pilgrimage to Rome.

Dogar, S.

*Annexed*

-This fictionalized account of the two Jewish families in hiding, including Anne Frank, is told from the point of view of Anne's companion in the secret annex, fifteen-year-old Peter van Pels.

Elliot, L.

*A Troubled Peace*

-*Sequel to Under a War-torn Sky*; World War II may be ending, but for nineteen-year-old pilot Henry Forester the conflict still rages.

Godbersen, A.

*The Luxe*

-In Manhattan in 1899, five teens of different social classes lead dangerously scandalous lives, despite the strict rules of society and the best-laid plans of parents and others.

Graber, J.

*The White Witch*

-The Great Plague has come to England, and no one is safe, least of all Gwendoline Riston. With fair skin and hair and a way with plants and animals, the villagers are calling her a witch and blaming her for the disease.

Hiatt, S.

*Panama: a novel*

-After moving from a small town in Ohio to Panama while her father takes part in building the Panama Canal, a fifteen-year-old girl yearning for new experiences meets Frederico, a Spanish aristocrat who is working as a canal digger, and they begin a romance.

Ingold, J.

*Paper Daughter*

-When her father, a respected journalist in Seattle, is killed in a hit-and-run accident, Maggie Chen, a high school intern at her father's newspaper, searches for clues to the mysterious circumstances surrounding his death, an investigation that forces her to confront her ethnicity and a family she never knew.

Levithan, D.

*Love is the Higher Law*

-Three New York City teens express their reactions to the bombing of the World Trade Center on September 11, 2001, and its impact on their lives and the world.

Riordan, J.

*Rebel Cargo*

-Abena, a rebellious Ashanti girl sold into slavery, meets up with kidnapped and enslaved white cabin boy Mungo on the route from West Africa to Jamaica. Together they escape to a rumored stronghold of runaway slaves in the Blue Mountains. But can they slip through the hordes of Redcoats and baying bloodhounds to find freedom?
