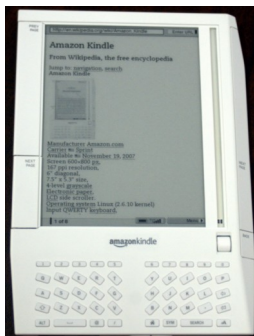


Identifying Your Kindle

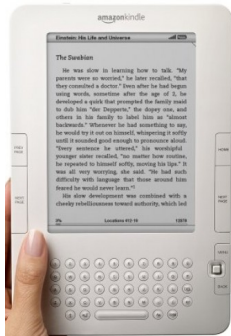
Kindles without Wi-Fi:

(transfer titles via USB cord)

- Kindle 1st Generation (has keyboard)
- Kindle 2nd Generation 3G (has keyboard)
- Kindle DX 3G (9 inch display)



1st Gen.

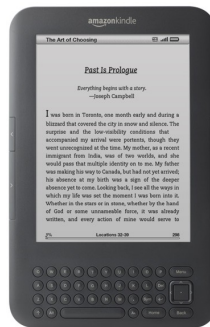


2nd Gen.

Kindles with Wi-Fi:

(transfer titles directly from Internet to device)

- Kindle 3rd Generation Wi-Fi + 3G (has keyboard)
- Kindle 4th Generation Wi-Fi + 3G (has 5 buttons on bottom)
- Kindle Touch Wi-Fi + 3G (has one Home button on bottom)
- Kindle Fire Tablet Wi-Fi

In order to download library ebooks, Kindle users need to connect the Kindle to an available Wi-Fi network. To connect to a Wi-Fi network [check your Kindle user manual](#). The following steps are general and apply specifically to those with a Kindle 3rd Generation.

Kindle users with 3G will also need to connect to Wi-Fi, rather than use the device's 3G connection.

Connect to a Wi-Fi network at home:

- Press the Home button on your Kindle
- Press the Menu button
- Navigate to Settings and select it
- Navigate to Wi-Fi Settings and select View

(If you do not have an option for Wi-Fi settings, you have a 1st or 2nd generation Kindle and must transfer titles using a USB cord.)

- Select a network and choose Connect. If you see a lock symbol next to Connect, the Wi-Fi network requires a password, which you will have to enter. This password only needs to be entered one time.

Connect to a Wi-Fi network in the library:

- Press the Home button on your Kindle
- Press the Menu button
- Navigate to Settings and select it
- Navigate to Wi-Fi Settings and select View

(If you do not have an option for Wi-Fi settings, you have a 1st or 2nd generation Kindle and must transfer titles using a USB cord.)

- Select the CNQTLIB network and choose Connect. The Kindle will ask you to launch the browser.
- Read the library's wireless use policy and choose the I Agree button to connect to the library's free Wi-Fi.
