




Setting up the free Libby app


- Make sure your device is connected to a wireless network.
- Visit your device's App Store (Apple) or Play Store (Android).
- Tap Search and search for Libby. The app will display in the search results.
- Tap the Install button.
 - Apple users may be prompted to enter an Apple ID Password.
 - Android users, tap the Accept button.
- The app will install. A shortcut will appear on your home screen.
- Open the app.
- You will be asked if you have a library card. Tap Yes to begin.




Tap I'll Search For A Library.




Search by **zip code** or **Connetquot**. Select **Livebrary.com**.



Tap Connetquot Public Library and fill in your library card number, then tap Sign In.



Use the **Toolbar** at the bottom of the screen to navigate around the app.



Checking Out an eBook/eAudiobook




Use the Magnifying Glass Button to search for a book. Type in the name of a title, author, or series.




Or, use the **Library Button** to browse the site to find a book of interest.

After you find a title to check out, tap **Borrow**.




Select your loan period, then tap **Borrow!**



Tap Open Book.



Select **Libby** format to read in the app.



Your eBook will open.

- Swipe from right to left to turn pages.
- Libby will remember what page you left off on when you stop reading.



Adjust Reading Settings with the Toolbar

Tap the center of the screen to bring up the toolbar:



Toggle the **Appearance Icon** to change the **Text Scale**, **Lighting**, and **Font**.



Toggle the **Search Icon** to search a **word**, **phrase** or **sentence** within the book.




Toggle the **Bookmark & Highlights Icon** to bookmark a particular page or highlight a particular word, phrase, or passage.



The ruler at the bottom shows your location within the book and the number of pages until the next chapter or break.

Chapter breaks are indicated by a vertical black line on the ruler.



Titles do not need to be returned early, they will expire at the end of the loan period. However, if you wish to return a title:

- Tap Manage Loan
- Then tap Return Early.
