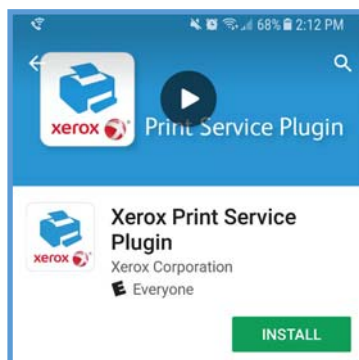




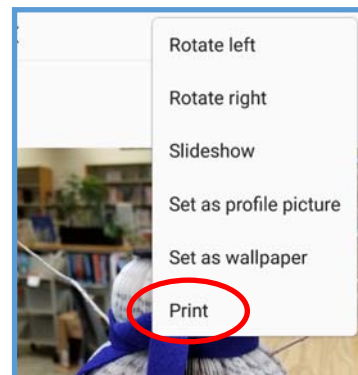
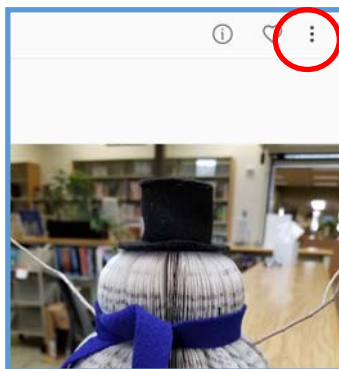

Wireless Printing for Android

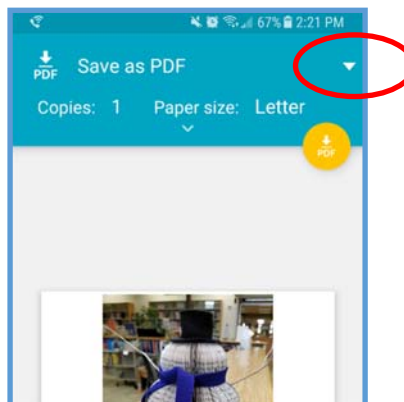
1. Go to the Play Store – download the **Xerox Print Service Plugin**



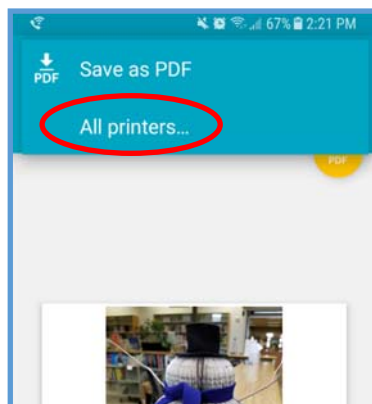
2. Open the item to be printed (a picture or email, etc.) and tap the button with the three dots to open the menu. Then, tap **Print**.



3. At the top of screen, the printer may default to Save as PDF. Tap the drop-down triangle.



4. Tap **All Printers**

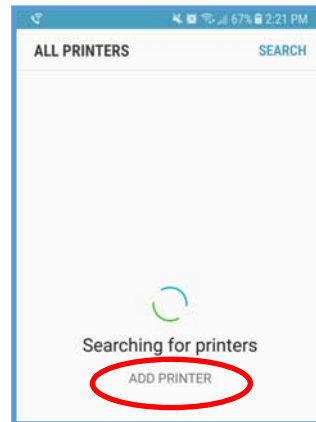




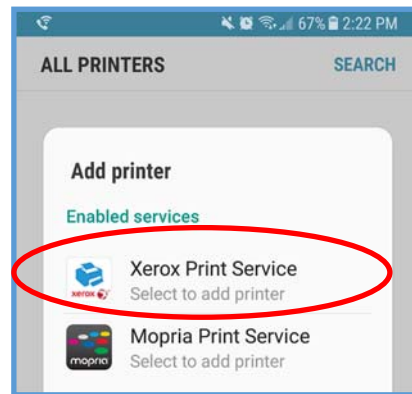

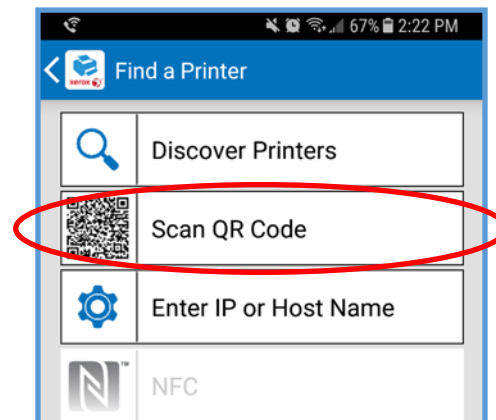
5. The phone or tablet will try to search for a printer. Tap **Add Printer**.



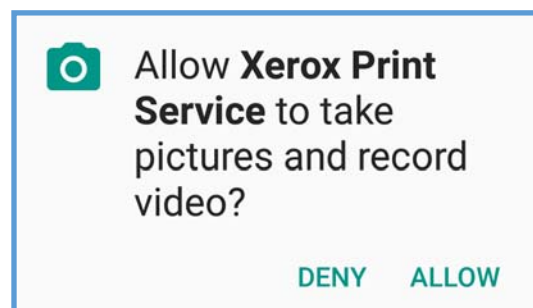
6. Tap **Xerox Print Service Select to add printer**



7. Tap **Scan QR Code**



8. If asked “Allow Xerox Print Service to take pictures and record video?” – Tap **Allow**

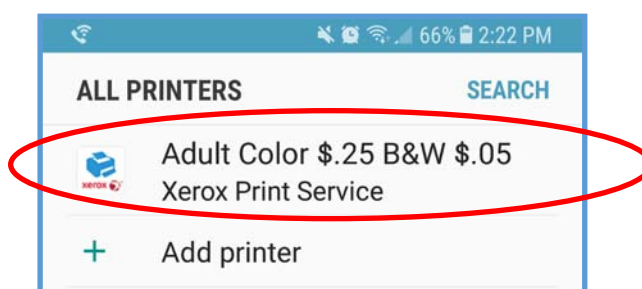
9. Scan the QR code to the right, or bring your phone or device to the Adult Services Desk and ask to scan the QR code. After scanning, your device will register the printer.



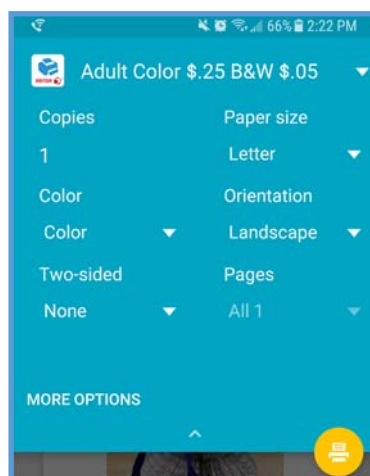
Printer Found and Added to the Xerox Print Service printer list

10. Tap away from the Print Services menu and you will now see a printer listed as:
Adult Color \$.25 B&W \$.05

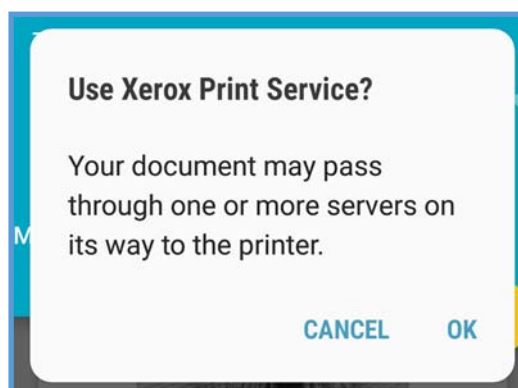
Then, Tap the Printer Name



11. Tap the down arrow next to Paper Size to make changes to: paper size (*must be Letter*), orientation, number of copies, color or B&W, two-sided or one-sided.



12. If you are asked: "Use Xerox Print Service? Your document may pass through one or more servers on its way to the printer" -- Tap **OK**



Your item will now print at the Adult Services Desk.
