The house is on the west side of Awixa Avenue on a large parcel among other residences of similiar age and type that line the road. A wooded area remains on the east side of the road opposite the house, south of a recently constructed condominium development.

18. OTHER NOTABLE FEATURES OF BUILDING AND SITE (including interior features if known):

The house is a large, $2\frac{1}{2}$ story, gambrel roof house set perpendicular to the street with a wrap around porch that contains a porte cochere on the north and an octagonal pavillion on the south. These features contain Tuscan columns. A fanlight is centered in the gambrel peak of the principle facade. 8/2 sash windows remain throughout the house.
