



The gable peaks feature round headed windows with Gothic style muntins. Italianate brackets line the eaves and rakes. Other features include 2/2 windows and a double leaf panelled entrance door with sidelights and a transom.

	Richard Rhodes was born in Bay Shore in 1827 and married Salina L'Hommedieu in 1851. Richard Rhodes followed the sea for thirty years taking to market the largest cargo of produce and bay food of any vessel plying between Long Island towns and New York markets. His son, Capt. Urias, was also a noted sea captain. Capt. Urias sailed many famous New York Yacht Club yachts.
