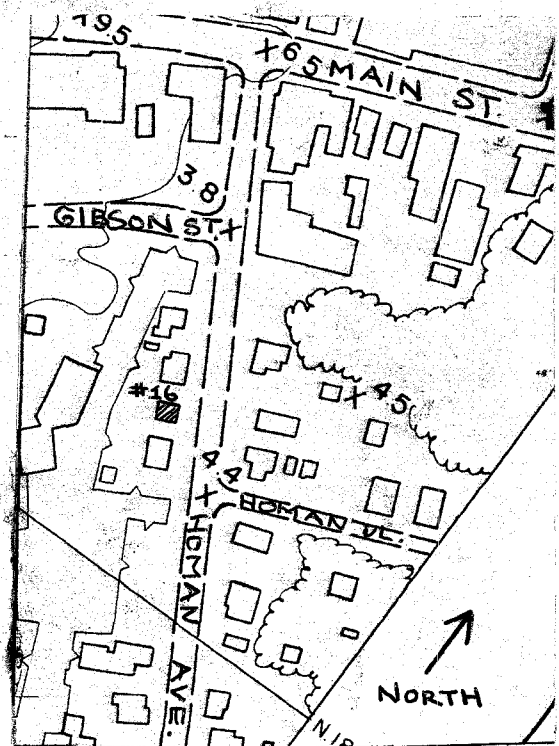

This house is in a residential area which runs south from Main Street to the Great South Bay. There are numerous houses of architectural significance in the area, ranging from large Victorian houses to baymen's cottages. Homan Avenue is a short street with smaller houses and cottages predominating.

18. OTHER NOTABLE FEATURES OF BUILDING AND SITE (including interior features if known):

This one and one-half story cottage is three bays wide. The north side is one bay wide, but there is a saltbox profile at the southern end due to the addition of a lean-to. The upper story of the front facade has altered "lie-on-your-stomach" windows.

20. HISTORICAL AND ARCHITECTURAL IMPORTANCE:

This building has been altered, but it retains the aura of a small rural house with "lie-on-your-stomach" windows and a lean-to. There are three six-over-six windows on the front facade, and twin three-over-three windows on the south side. The horizontal siding is about ten inches wide. The open porch with posts ~~may be~~ a later addition.

Because the house was located on a creek, the bayman's boat could be kept nearby, maybe Geo. Cove on Beers Comstock Atlas of Long Island 1873.

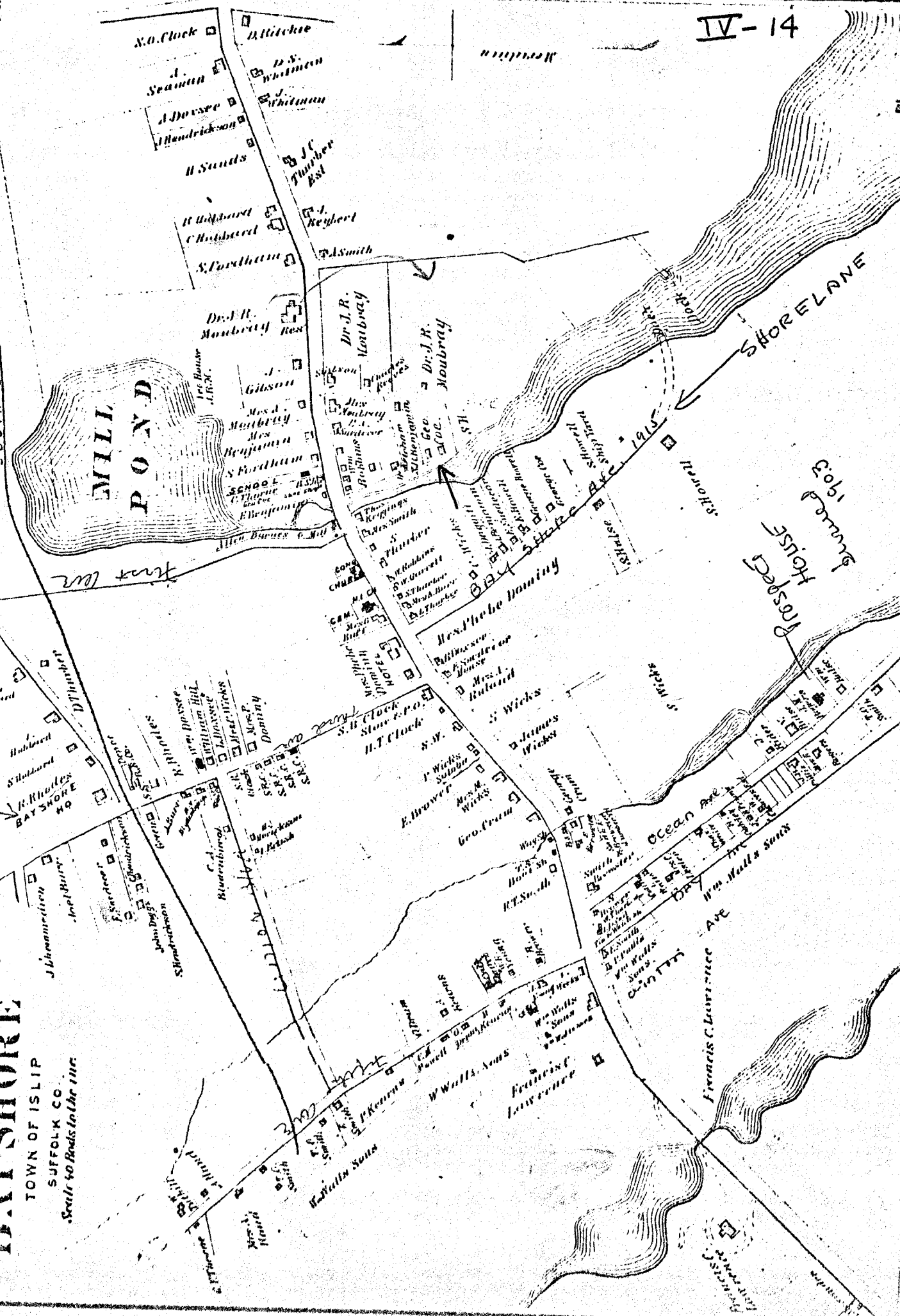
