

There is a decorative quarter sunburst on either side of the gable window, and a molded panel below. The vergeboard is simply decorated. 20 HISTORICAL AND ADOLHTECTURAL IMPORTANCE	
20. HISTORICAL AND ARCHITECTURAL IMPORTANCE: This house is a fine example of the Queen Anne style with its	
mixture of surface materials - fish-scale shingle and clapboard,	
its projections, and decorative detail. There is a large original	
porch with turned posts and simple balustrade extending across the front and sides of the house. There is a diamond-paned window on	
the first floor. The detail in the gable, including the sun-burst	
motif and extended rafters are fine example's of the period's	
ornamental detailing.
