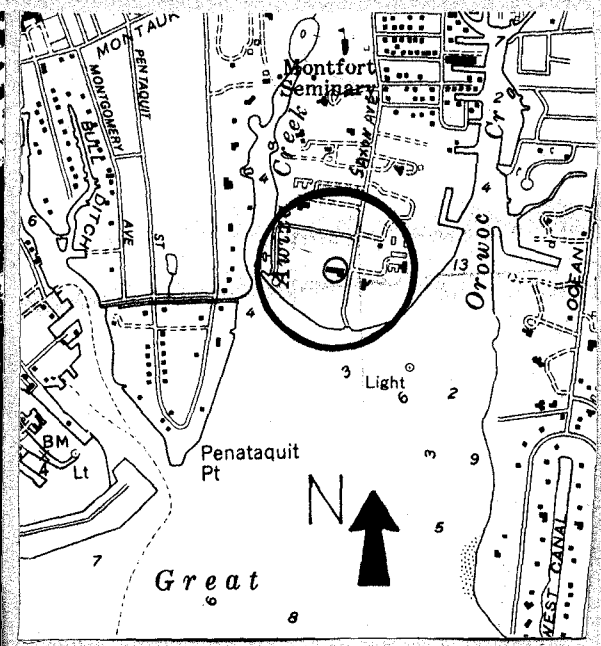

96 Saxon Avenue is located near the peninsula point created by Awixa Creek to the west, Great Cove to the south, and Orowoc Creek to the east. It is surrounded by both older and newer houses on large parcels that fill the peninsula. The house is set perpendicular to the street.

18. OTHER NOTABLE FEATURES OF BUILDING AND SITE (including interior features if known):

96 Saxon Avenue is a large, 2½ story, rectangular, five bay, gable roof house with end chimneys. An extended, 1½ story, gable roof wing on the east contains an incorporated garage/brick walled driveway court near Saxon Avenue. The central entrance contains sidelights and a transom under a pedimented entrance porch with large elliptical fanlight.

20. HISTORICAL AND ARCHITECTURAL IMPORTANCE:

This house was designed in the "Long Island Farmhouse Style" by Mr. Horace Havemeyer with the assistance of E.W. Howell who was the contractor. They incorporated certain parts of the 1917 house that was torn down at that time and was replaced with this present structure. The brick garage and wall remain from that earlier house which had been designed in 1917 by H.T. Lindeberg for Mr. Horace Havemeyer.

The Lindeberg house that was torn down was illustrated in House Beautiful of February 1925, pages 130 and 131.

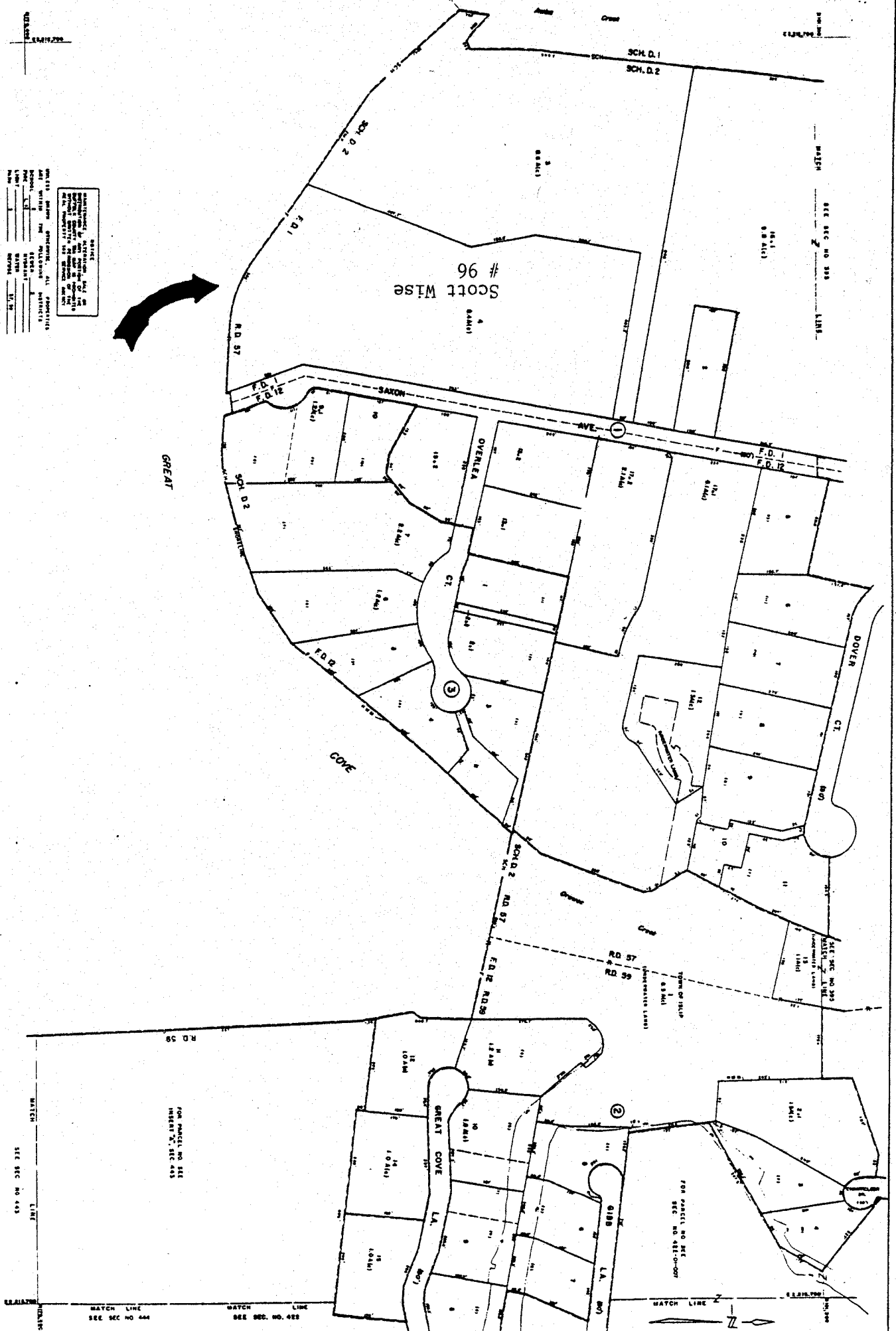

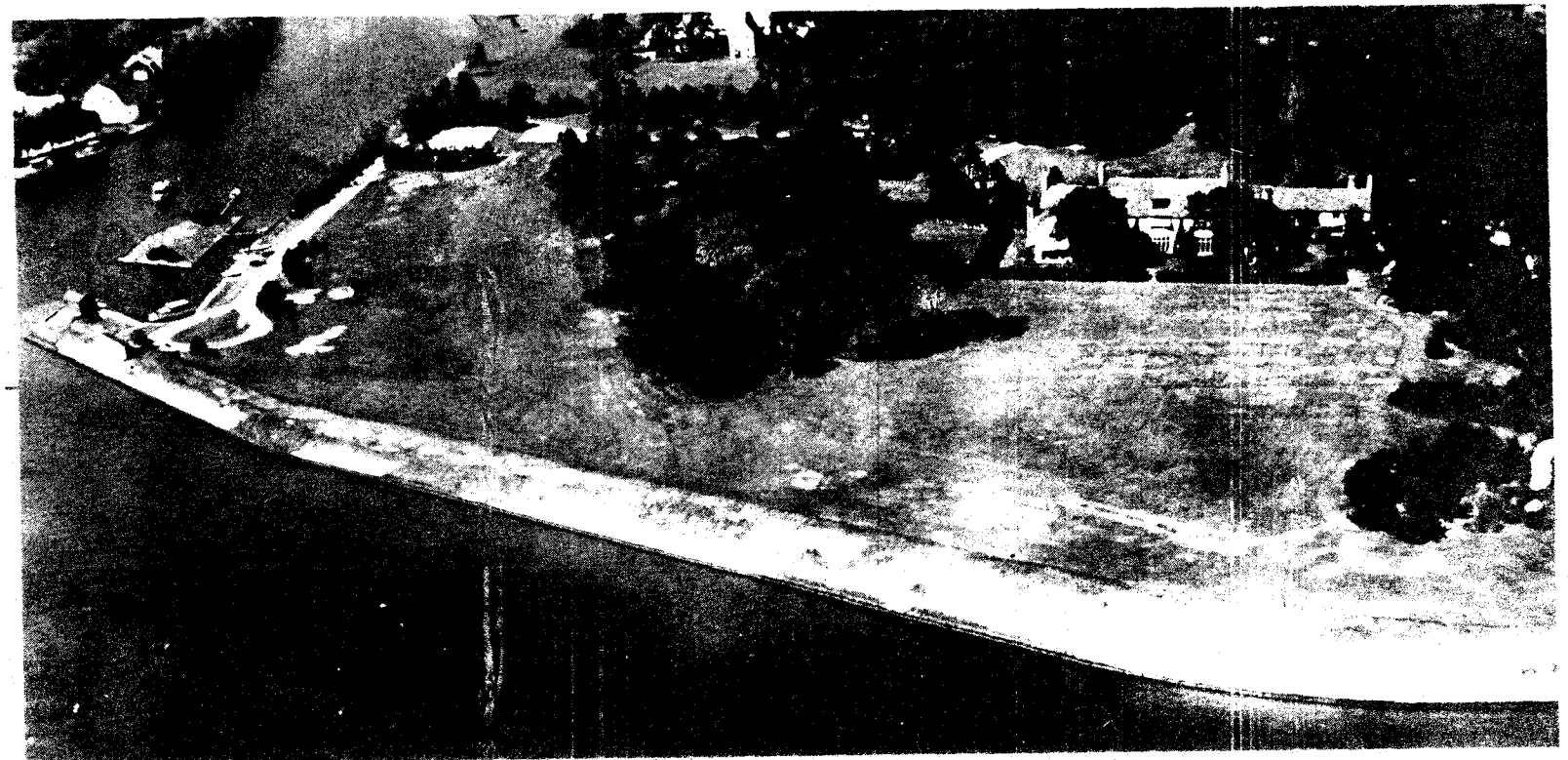

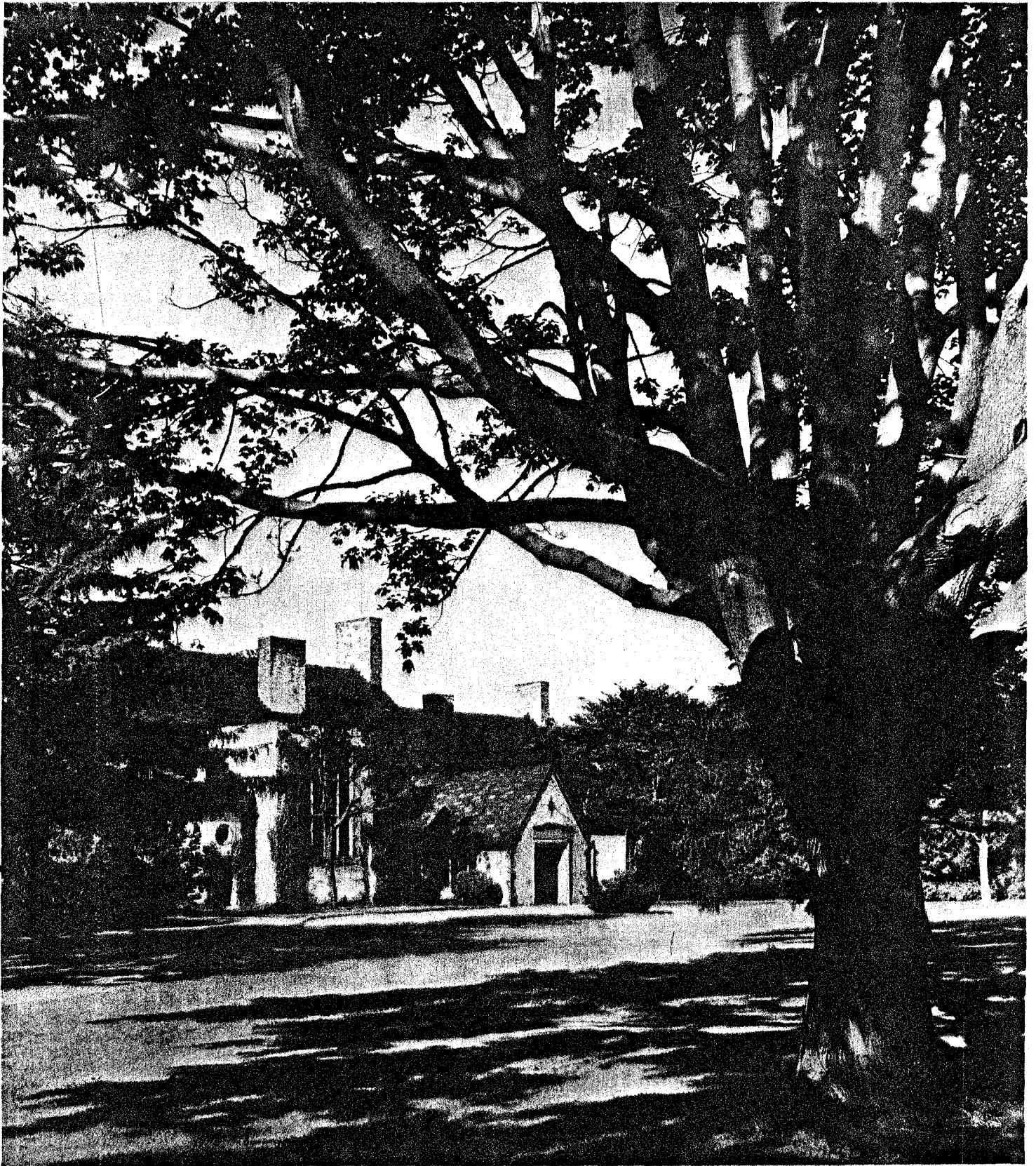
View of Olympic Point from the air, taken in 1938 before the great Hurrican of that year.

and by young Juan Ceballos of the Spanish and Cuban sugar family that lived in Bay Shore, north of the Main Road opposite "Chewing Gum" Adams. Gold and sail boat racing were still very much in favor and to engage in those sports a new club was born.
At the place where the Connetquot River flows into the Great South Bay a point of land protrudes southeastward towards Fire Island. It is known as

Club. The club was the first in the area to offer both golf and sailing to its members, and during the decades of the 20's and 30's it was a great success. It was not the first golf course to have been built, however. That distinction belonged to what was called the Westbrook Golf Club, a nine-hole course built in 1895 on property belonging to W. Bayard Cutting, a part of the old Lorillard horse farm. Harry B.

Point course was considered particularly challenging, as it was laid out along the Bay in the Scottish manner and often had to be played in "the teeth of the gale".

Just up the river from Timber Point was a natural cove to moor sailboats out of the chop of the Bay, and here the Timber Point class sailboats lay when not in use. These 17-foot racing sloops were owned by the club members and
