



The gable windows are pointed. The foundation is brick. |

The building is cross gabled; there is a projecting bay window on the north side, with a rectangular projection above it. The front door has a transom and sidelights. The windows, other than the gable windows, are rectangular with dentils at the heads. The first floor front windows reach almost to the floor level. |
