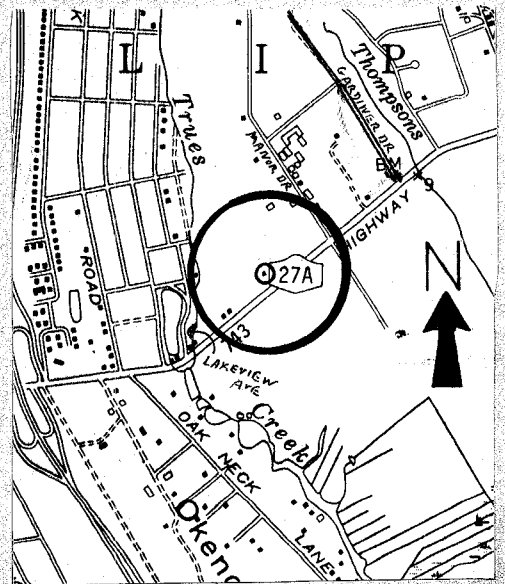

715 South Country Road is located on the north side of the historic street opposite Gardiner County Park, a large wooded and open tract south of the highway. The house is one of several residences along South Country Road on large parcels.

18. OTHER NOTABLE FEATURES OF BUILDING AND SITE (including interior features if known):

715 South Country road is a large, 2½ story, three bay, side entrance plan, gable end to the street house with a wrap-around porch. The house features a darted vergeboard and molded window lintels. The entrance door contains a transom and sidelights. A two story flat roof wing is attached to the west.
