

18.	OTHER NOTABLE FEATURES OF BUILDING AND SITE (including interior features if known):
	The MHT Branch Bank Building is a small, one story, concrete cylindrical building with walls that curve into the ground forming an almost complet oval. Three hexagonal windows mark the round-walled facades beside flat roof projections over the drive-through teller areas. The cylinder is topped with a truncated concrete fin.
