Entrance with sidelights. Later additions on north. This was known as the Brown Farm and owned by S. Brown in 1858 and in 1873. Later it was moved back on the property. It was owned by W.B. Moore in 1915; on that Atlas, three outbuildings are shown, two of which survive as residences, #s 31 and 36 Spray Court.
