

The Kroupa House is located on the NE corner of Smithtown Ave. and Kahle St., on a large parcel. It is surrounded by residences of similar age and slightly smaller scale with the exception of the property directly south, a neighborhood bakery and store.

18. OTHER NOTABLE FEATURES OF BUILDING AND SITE (including interior features if known):

The Kroupa House is a 2½ story, three bay, side entrance plan, gable roof house with a semi-wrap around porch on the south west corner supported on Tuscan columns. A large, 2½ story, gable roof wing is attached to the east.
