	time as the Quonnahasset Hotel. It is one of Brentwood's most
	architecturally significant buildings. The combination of
	Mansard roofed flanking bays and center protruding bay with
	pedimented roof are all a part of the eclecticism of the
	period in which the building was constructed. The flaring
	out of the shingles above the storefront level is also of
	interest. Although the building is suffering from a certain
	amount of deterioration it still retains its integrity.
