

	notable for its employment of two different roof types - the
	gable and the gambrel. The interplay of these basic roof
	forms and the use of varying types of exterior covering materials
	indicate Queen Anne design. The house can be found on
	a 1915 Atlas of Brentwood to belong to C.B. Cooper. It is
	still in the Cooper family and has remained unchanged significantlesince 1915.
