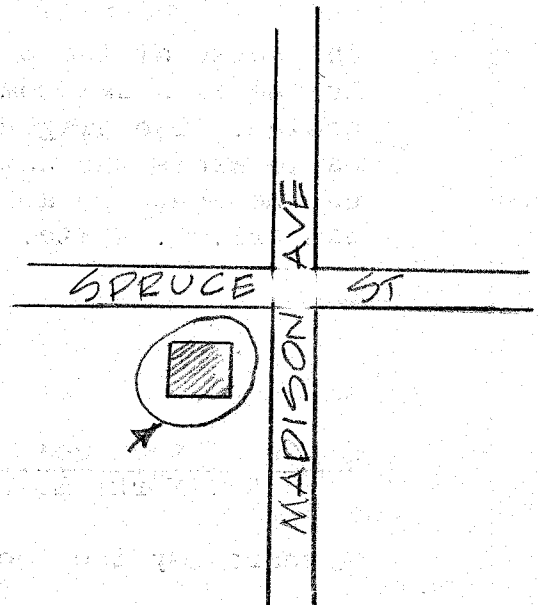

 Variegated shingles in gable. Swag in gable under rectangular window with two side panels. Shutters (Closed). Original porch surrounding house. Flaring out at gable level with cornice line below flare. Bays extending out of sides.

20. HISTORICAL AND ARCHITECTURAL IMPORTANCE:
 The house at the Southwest corner of Spruce St. and Madison Avenue is a handsome two and one half story Queen Anne design. The swag under the rectangular windows of the gable shows the date of the house to be 1892. The house can be found on a 1915 Atlas of Brentwood on which the owner was Mrs. M. White.
