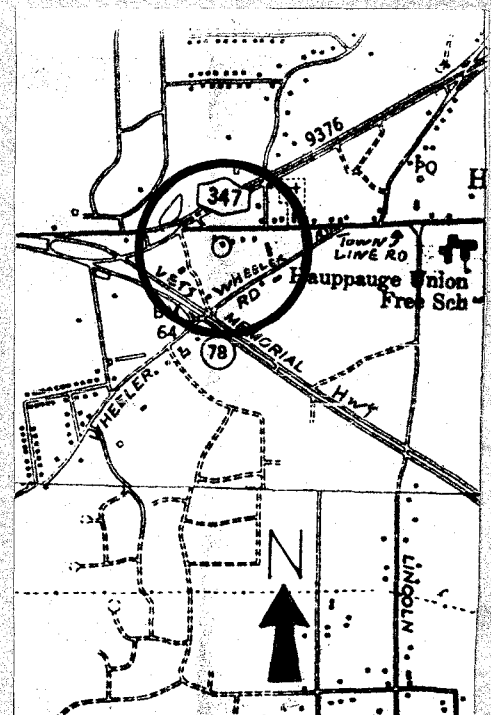

- 420 Town Line Road, on a large open parcel dotted with mature trees, is part of a row of four bungalows that line the south side of Town Line Road between the Brookside Dr. Extension and the Veteran's Memorial Hwy. intersection. A large modern office bldng. stands directly north.
18. OTHER NOTABLE FEATURES OF BUILDING AND SITE (including interior features if known):
- 420 Town Line Rd. is a 1½ story, shingled, gable roof, Arts & Crafts style house with a deep shed roof porch supported by short wide posts characteristic of the style. A shed roof dormer with exposed rafter ends occupies the north roof slope. The rear (south) roof slope breaks more than half the distance from the ridge. The east wall contains a semi-
