





Click **Sign in** on the right-hand side.

Search for a title to check out





Use the Magnifying Glass Button to search for a book. Type in the name of a title, author, or series.



Or, use the **Library Button** to browse the site to find a book of interest.


- After finding an eAudbook you would like to read, click Borrow.
- Some titles can be borrowed for 7
 days, 14 days or 21 days. Click the
 loan period to change the length of
 time you would like.
- Then, click Borrow.
- Choose Open Audiobook







Playing an eAudiobook in the Browser





Use the **Play/Pause** button to start or stop the audio.



Use the **15s** button to skip 15 seconds backward or forward in the audiobook.



Click the **Playback Speed** button to adjust the speed of the narrator.




Use the **Sleep Timer** button to set a stop time.



The **Bookmarks Folder** button will have a list of all the bookmarks you have set throughout the audiobook.



Use the **Bookmarks & Highlights** button to highlight a particular audio passage.



The ruler at the bottom shows your location within the audiobook and the number of minutes until the next chapter or break.

Chapter breaks are indicated by a vertical black line on the ruler.

Returning an eAudiobook

It is not necessary to return your eAudiobooks early. eAudiobooks will expire automatically at the end of the loan period. However, if you wish, you can return most titles early:
