



Use the Magnifying Glass Button to search for a book. Type in the name of a title, author, or series.




Or, use the **Library Button** to browse the site to find a book of interest.

 After finding an eBook you would like to read, click Borrow.




- Some titles can be borrowed for 7 days, 14 days or 21 days. Click the loan period to change the length of time you would like.

- Choose Go to Shelf





To Read Offline on your PC or Transfer to an eReader:

- FIRST: You will need the free software
 Adobe Digital Editions downloaded on your computer. Go to https://www.adobe.com/solutions/ebook/digital-editions/download.html to download and install this software.
- To read offline on your PC or to transfer to an older eReader, you will choose Other Options.



• Then choose EPUB



- The eBook will download on your computer. Click the file name located in the bottom left-hand corner of the screen and then choose to open it with Adobe Digital Editions. You may begin reading on screen.
- To transfer to an eReader:

With Adobe Digital Editions open, plug your ereader

into your computer. Drag the book jacket from the Adobe Digital Editions Library to the ereader listed on the left hand side.
