

Download the Libby app on your phone or Kindle Tablet:

- Visit your device's App Store
- Search for **Libby**. The app will display in the search results.
- Tap **Install**.
- Open the app and follow the prompts.

Search for a title to check out

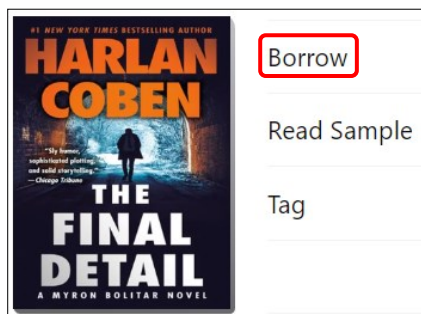


Use the **Magnifying Glass Button** to search for a book. Type in the name of a title, author, or series.

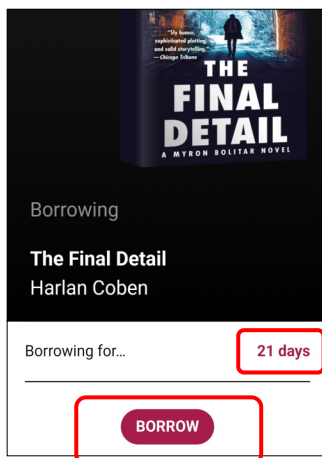


Or, use the **Library Button** to browse the site to find a book of interest.

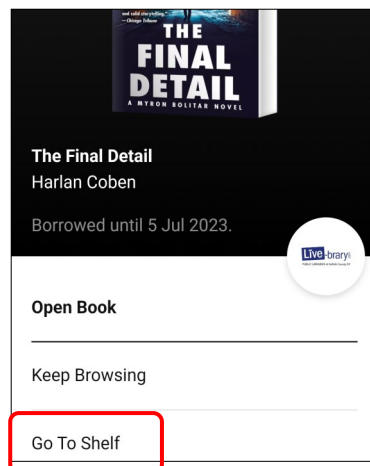
- After you find a title to check out, tap **Borrow**.



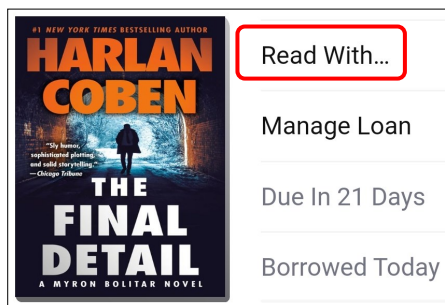
- Select the loan period, then tap **Borrow**



- Tap **Go To Shelf**



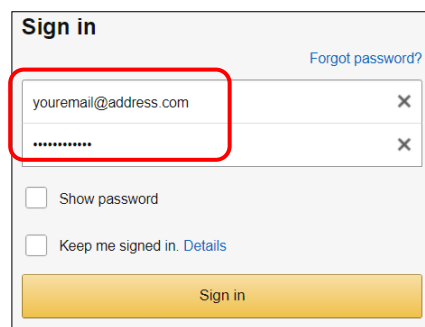
- Tap **Read With**



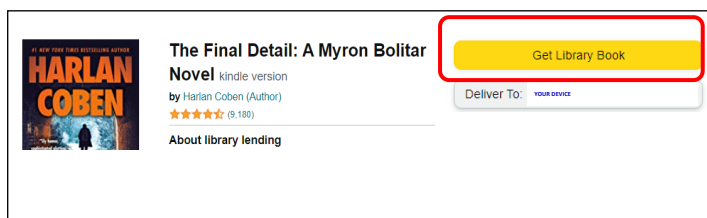
- Select **Kindle** format



- You will be directed to Amazon which will deliver the eBook to your Kindle. **Sign in with your Amazon login.**



- Click the **Get Library Book** button.




- You will receive a confirmation and the book will download to your Kindle.

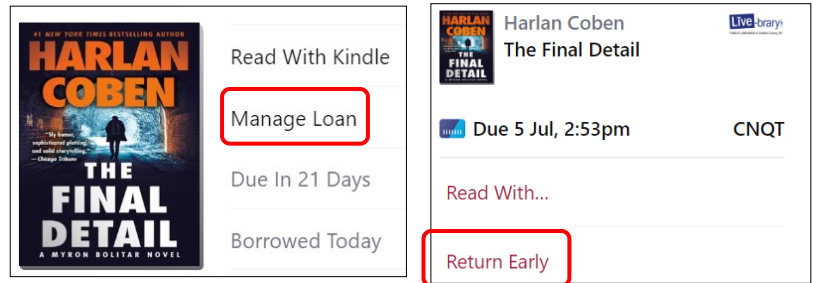


Your digital library book will be delivered the next time <<your Kindle device>> syncs. If you would like to manage your digital titles, go to [Manage Your Content and Devices](#).

Returning a Kindle eBook

Ebooks do not need to be returned early, they will expire at the end of the loan period. However, if you wish to return a title early:

- Open the Libby app or visit libbyapp.com/library/livebrary in the web browser and click on the **Shelf** icon in the bottom 
- Locate the eBook on your bookshelf and click **Manage Loan**, then **Return Early**.



The following steps are for computer users who do not have a Wi-Fi connection and need to download eBooks to your Kindles manually using a USB cord.

After you have checked out your book and have fulfilled it on Amazon.com:

- Hover the mouse over your name in the top-right corner and then click **Content & Devices**
- Click **Books**
- Check the box next to the library eBook
- Click **More actions** on the menu
- Click **Download & transfer via USB**
- Confirm which device your book will be delivered to and click **Download**
- The file will download and appear in the bottom-left hand corner of your computer screen.
- Plug your Kindle into your computer
- Open File Explorer and click on the **Downloads** folder, which will show your book title
- Click on the down-arrow next to Kindle to reveal the folders
- Drag your ebook title from the main Downloads folder into the Kindle's Document's folder.
- You can now disconnect your Kindle from the computer and read your eBook.
